
# Panorama Year in Review 2023



### **Subscriptions**

Subscriptions are handled through MailChimp, a group email tool. Subscribers receive an email when each issue is published and receive other *Panorama*-specific mailings throughout the year (CFPs, grant awards, fundraising, etc.)

914 as of January 12, 2024 (+55, or +6.4%, from 2022)

**Open rate**<sup>1</sup> (people who open the email): 57.7% (+3.58 percentage points, or +6.14%, from 2022).

**Click rate**<sup>2</sup> (people who click through to get to our site): 5.43% (+.55 percentage points, or +11/27%, from 2022).



### Reader Acquisition<sup>7</sup>

We get the majority of our visitors through organic searches—someone Googles a topic or title and chooses us from a list of search results: 68% (63.9% in 2022). Other methods of acquisition include: direct searches, where someone types our name or address into a search field, 19% (23.9% in 2022); referral, where a user clicks on a direct link to our site from another place on the internet, like AHAA's website, 9.8% (8.4% in 2022); and social media, 3.1% (3.9% in 2021).

The percentage of social media acquisitions continues to be disappointing, particularly given a popular takeover of AHAA's social media accounts in June and November. In 2022 the data loss between November 17 and November 27 corresponded with that takeover, so we do not know if or how many visitors it drove to our site; however, we did expect the percentage of users acquired through social media to go up in 2023, and they did not.

That said, Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, and LinkedIn all appear in our list of top referrers, below, so it is clear that they drive visitors to our site to some extent.

2023 numbers indicate about 70% of our users come from desktop devices rather than mobile devices; this is up almost six percentage points from 2022, despite a drop of about three points between 2021 and 2022. The takeaway is that the desktop/mobile ratio has been hovering around 65/35 to 70/30 in recent years.
